### Covid-19 Volunteer Policy

This Volunteer Agreement is a description of the arrangement between Pride in Linthwaite CIC (hereafter referred to as 'PIL'), and any volunteers in relation to your voluntary work during any Covid-19 outbreaks. The intention of this agreement is to assure you that we appreciate your work with us and to show our commitment to protect your wellbeing at all times, to the best of our ability, based on the current knowledge and recommendations around Covid-19 at that specific moment in time.

We commit to the following:

#### **1. Induction and training**

- To signpost volunteers to our policies, and current Covid-19 recommendations as laid out by HM Government, NHS services and local government.

#### **2. Supervision, support and flexibility**

- To provide named contact(s) who will be available to discuss your volunteering and any associated problems or concerns regarding Covid-19.

#### **3. PPE**

- To be provided by PIL if currently recommended, social distancing encouraged and anti-viral hand gel, or other measures as per currently recommended, as reasonably practicable.

#### **4. Health and safety**

- To ensure that you understand the government guidelines in relation to Covid-19 to minimise the risk of spreading the virus and protect your health.

#### **5. Insurance**

- To provide adequate insurance cover for volunteers whilst undertaking voluntary work approved and authorised by us.

#### **6. Equal opportunities**

- To ensure that all volunteers are dealt with in accordance with our equal opportunities policy.

#### **7. Problems**

- To endeavour to resolve in a fair and just manner any problems, grievances or difficulties which may be encountered while you volunteer with us;
- In the event of an unresolved problem, to offer an opportunity to discuss the issues in accordance with the procedures set out in the Volunteers Policy.



By being signposted to this Policy, it is implied that you have understood and agreed to adhere to the organisation's rules, procedures and standards, including health and safety procedures and its equal opportunities policy in relation to its staff, volunteers and members of the public. To follow all government and NHS guidance to keep myself and others in the community safe during the Covid-19 pandemic.
